11 Essential Items They Need to Provide



What happens if they aren't:

Recently, this health organization agreed to **pay \$1.3 million to settle Office for Civil Rights (OCR) investigations** after multiple security incidents. Investigations had revealed “systemic, noncompliance with the HIPAA Rules,” including **failure to conduct a complete Security Risk Analysis** to determine risks and vulnerabilities to ePHI across the organization. The fine came with a three-year corrective action plan, beginning with a **thorough SRA** and the development of a **risk management plan**. *Would you face increased penalties due to unpreparedness?*

How You Can Tell if You're Prepared for a HIPAA Breach

Below are eleven things the government may ask you for. Run through this list as a quick way to assess if your IT vendor or consultant Security Risk Analysis will defend your organization:



Most recent enterprise-wide Security Risk Analysis (and sometimes the scheduled date of the next SRA)



Risk management plan in effect - your response to and actions taken on the SRA results



Details of policies and procedures in place: to prevent, detect and report malicious software; and to implement mechanisms to record and examine system activity, including audit log and access review



Security event response and reporting policy and procedure (was the procedure followed)



Full copy of the report/incident response documentation

Evidence of implemented procedures to create and maintain retrievable exact copies of ePHI



Policies and procedures for encrypting and decrypting ePHI

Policies and procedures to protect ePHI from improper alteration or destruction



Documentation on training program for employees

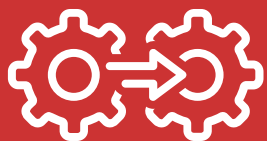
